



Tasks of a Co-Editor

Assess incoming manuscripts for relevance, quality and suitability for the next issue of the AWPL journal.

Select manuscripts for follow-up where appropriate.

When reviewers provide substantially different evaluations, assess their comments and recommend a decision to the Editors-in-Chief.

Provide advice when the Editors-in-Chief request a review of ethical or scientific standards for a specific submission.

Communicate clearly and professionally with authors, reviewers, and editorial staff.

Contribute to the development and implementation of the journal policy.

Identify emerging topics and encourage high-quality submissions in the field.

Handle assigned manuscripts promptly and maintain confidentiality at all times.

The editorial guidelines allow the Editor-in-Chief to remove Co- editors who do not follow the journal's policies or ethical standards.
